° Coats (Years 7-11)

School coats are part of the school uniform. We expect pupils to wear a School coat should they decide they need one. Two options are available – the Schoolblazer quilted jacket or the PlayerLayer Castle jacket. Pupils are not permitted to wear any other style of coat. If worn they will be asked to remove any other style of coat and not to bring it to School again.

Protective Equipment

All rugby and hockey players are strongly advised to wear shin pads and a mouth guard. Football players must wear shin pads.

The school will provide an opportunity to purchase mouth guards at the beginning of the Michaelmas Term.

Squash players are strongly advised to wear protective goggles.

Hair and Jewellery

- Hair should be tidy and of a natural colour. If haircuts are deemed inappropriate pupils will be asked to get it adjusted or not to return to school until it is deemed suitable.
- Boys must make sure they are clean shaven with the exception being on religious grounds
- Nail varnish should be of a neutral colour and nails should not be excessively long.

Permitted jewellery

- A single earring in each ear, small studs.
- No nose piercings.
- No chains/necklaces.
- No rings or bracelets.
